

Suggested Steps to take with regards of the CORONAVIRUS / COVID-19

Some groups have discussed making changes to customs at their meetings.

Some examples have included: Avoiding shaking hands and handholding; making sure meeting hospitality tables are sanitary; or suspending food hospitality for the time being. Regardless of group decisions, each individual is responsible for their own health decisions.

Some groups have considered contingency plans in case the group is temporarily unable to meet in person.

Plans have included: Creating contact lists and keeping in touch by phone, email or social media; meeting by phone or online. Providing members information for the *A.A. Online*
